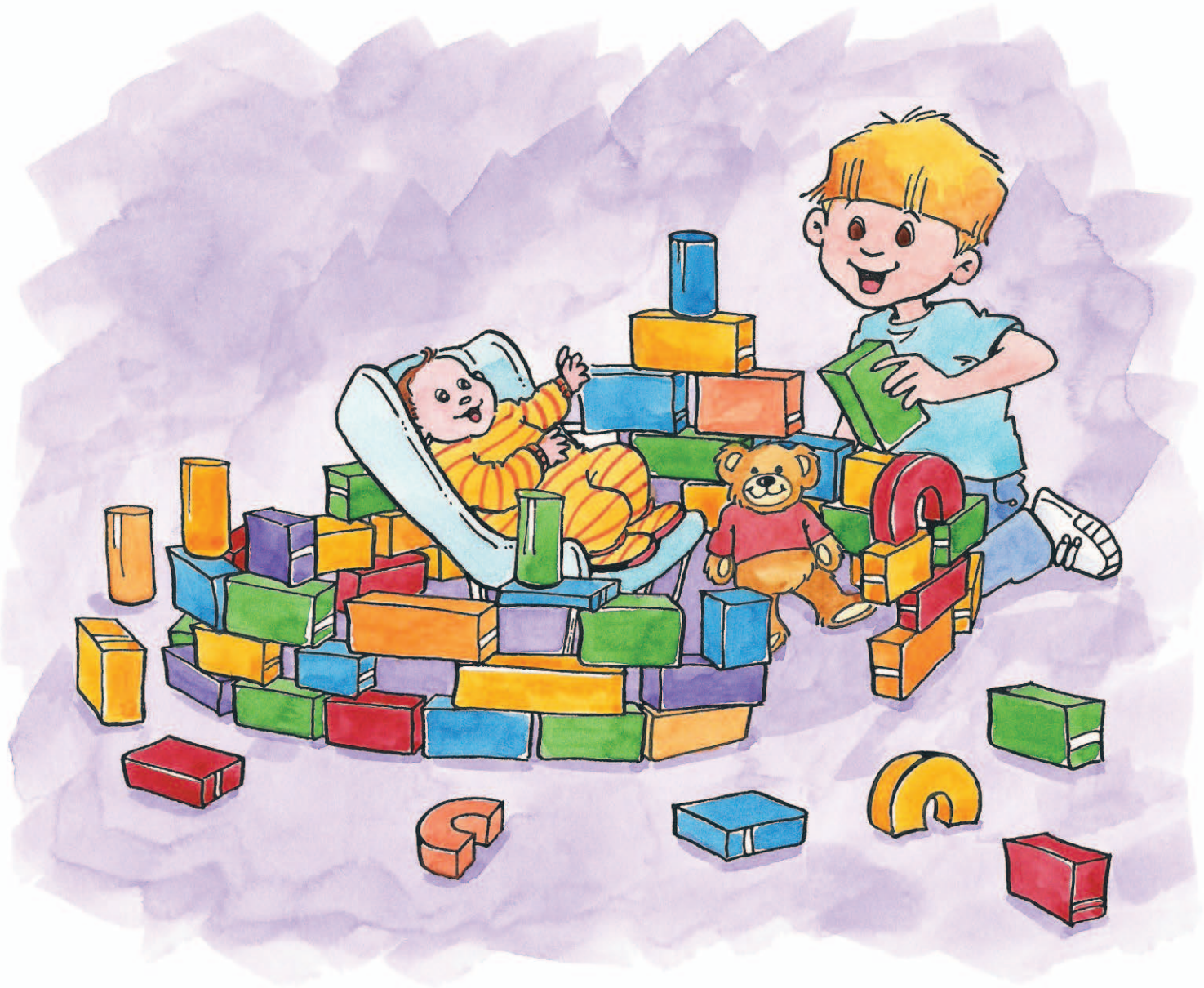
Hi! I'm the new baby! My name is _____.

I was born on _____.

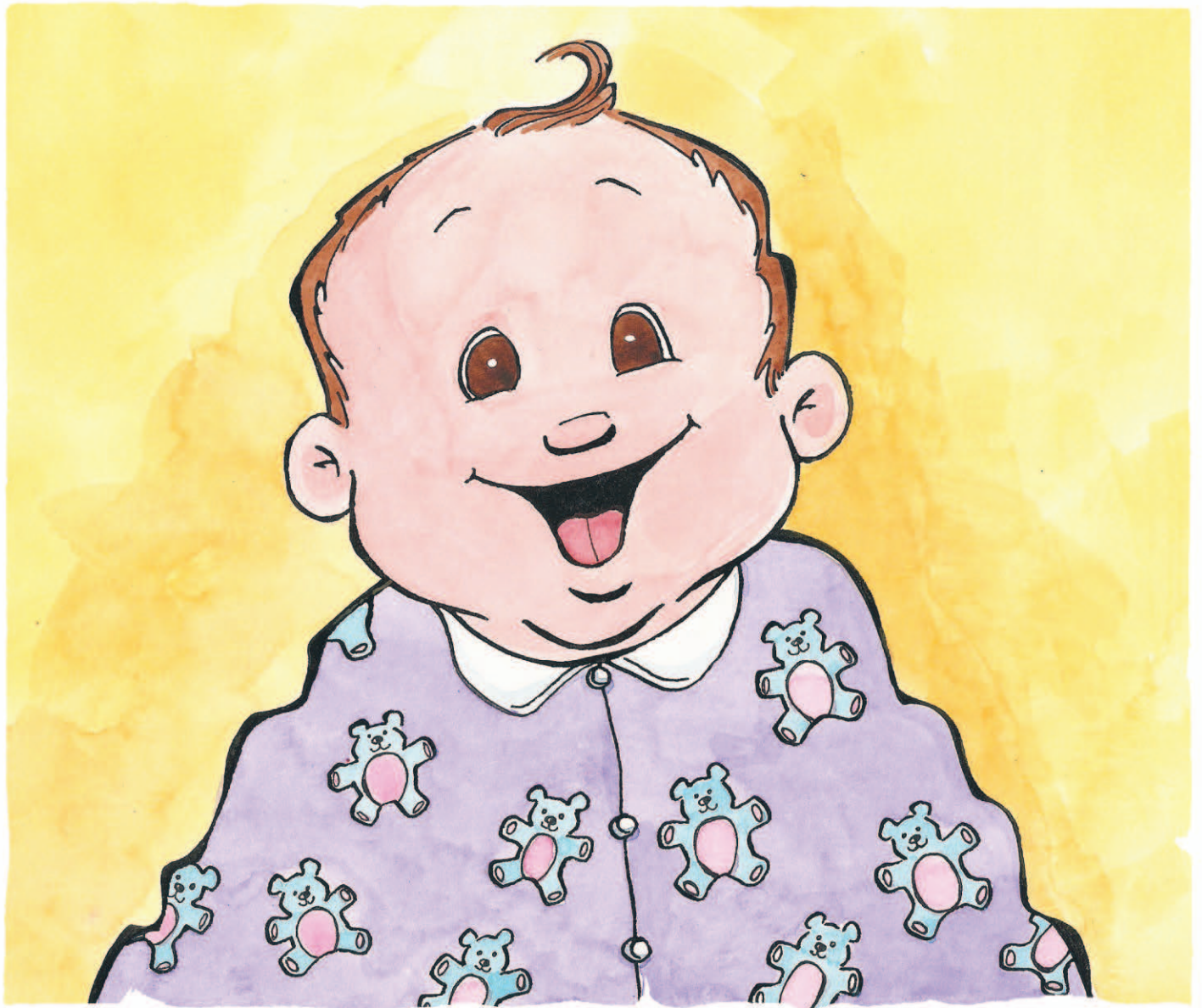
That's my birthday. When is your birthday?

I drink lots and lots of baby milk. What do you like to drink?



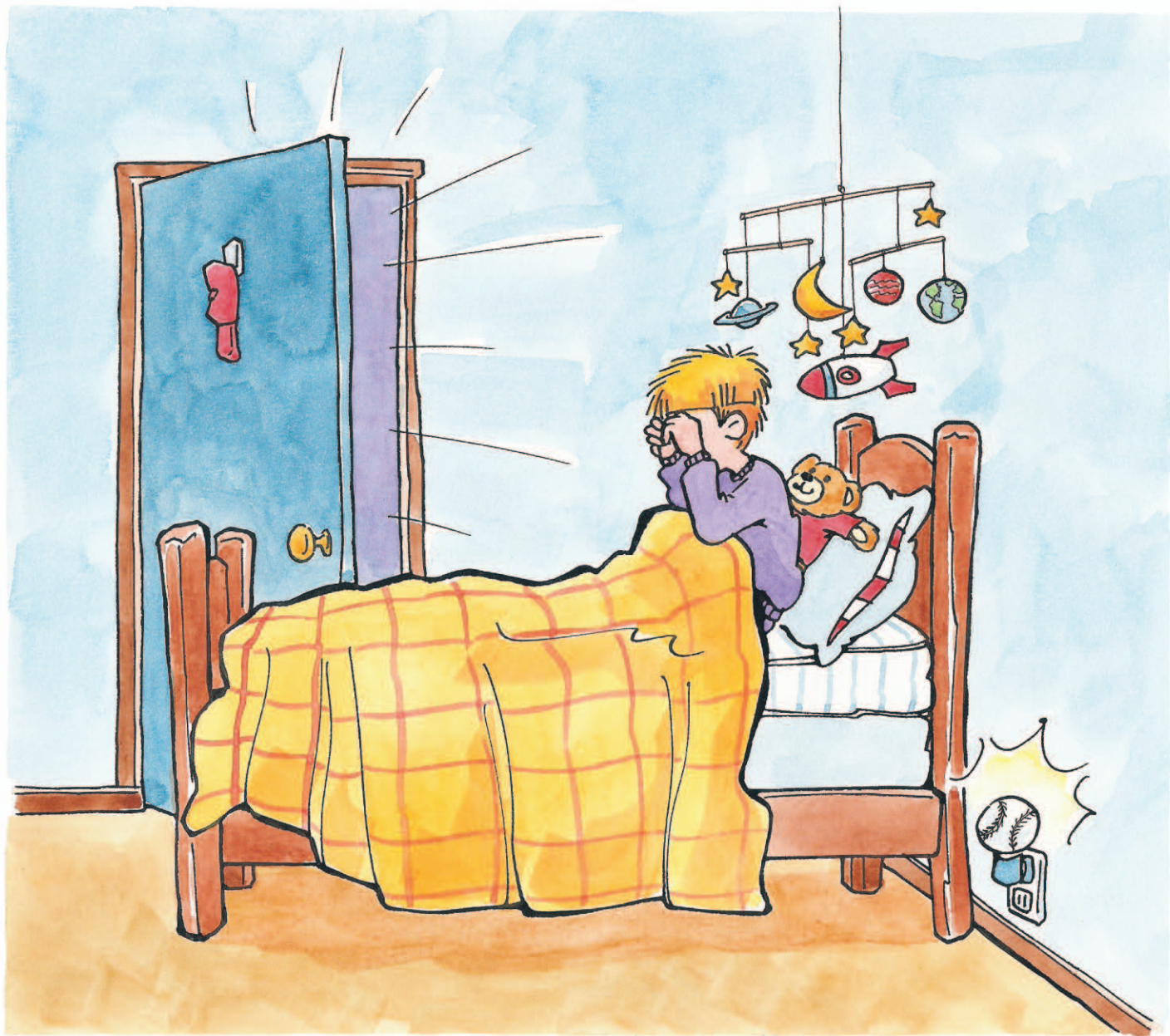
Big kids sleep in big-kid beds.

Sometimes I'll sleep while you're awake. Shhhhhhh.



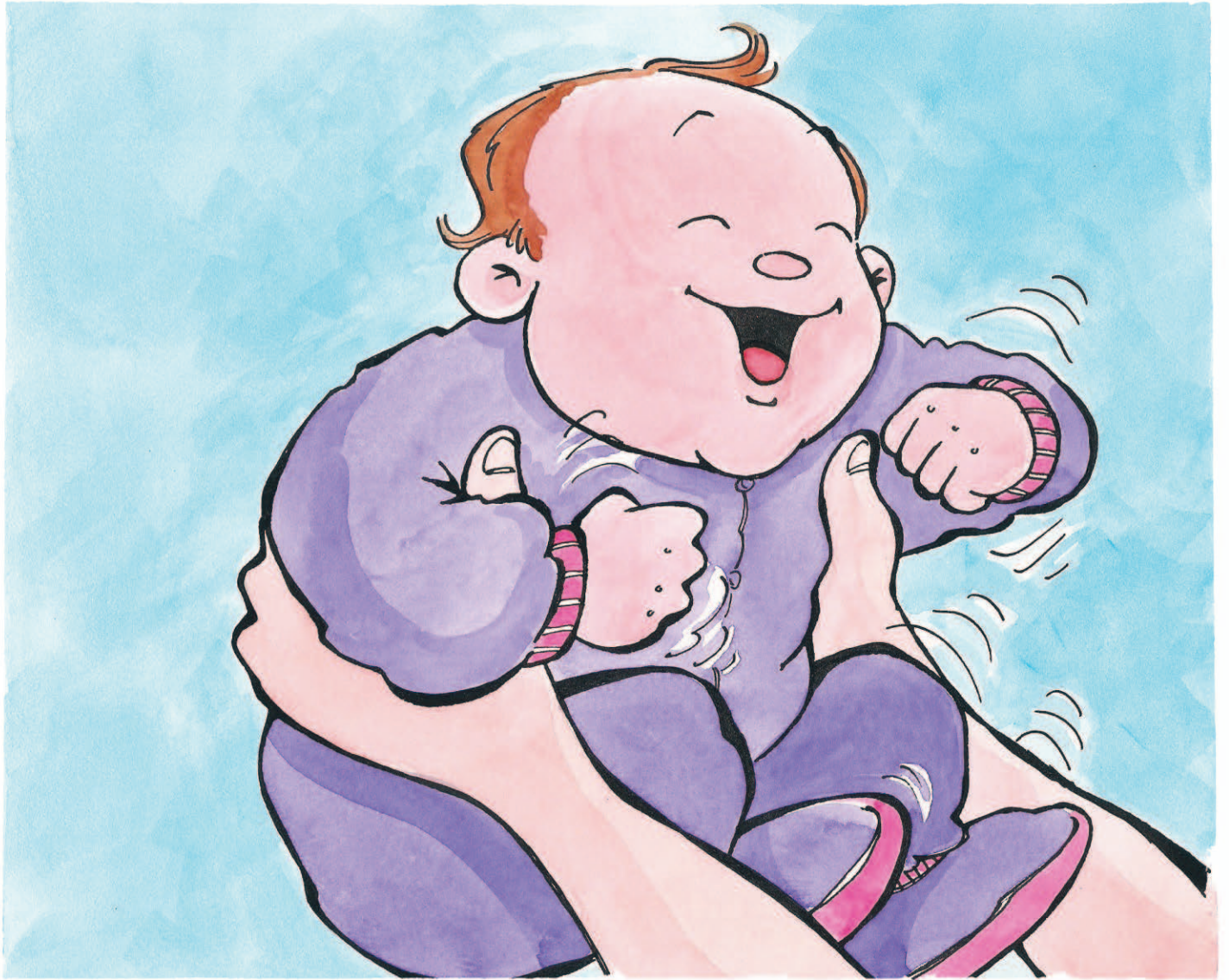
Other times I'll wake up while you're asleep. Waaaaahhhh! (Sorry.)
