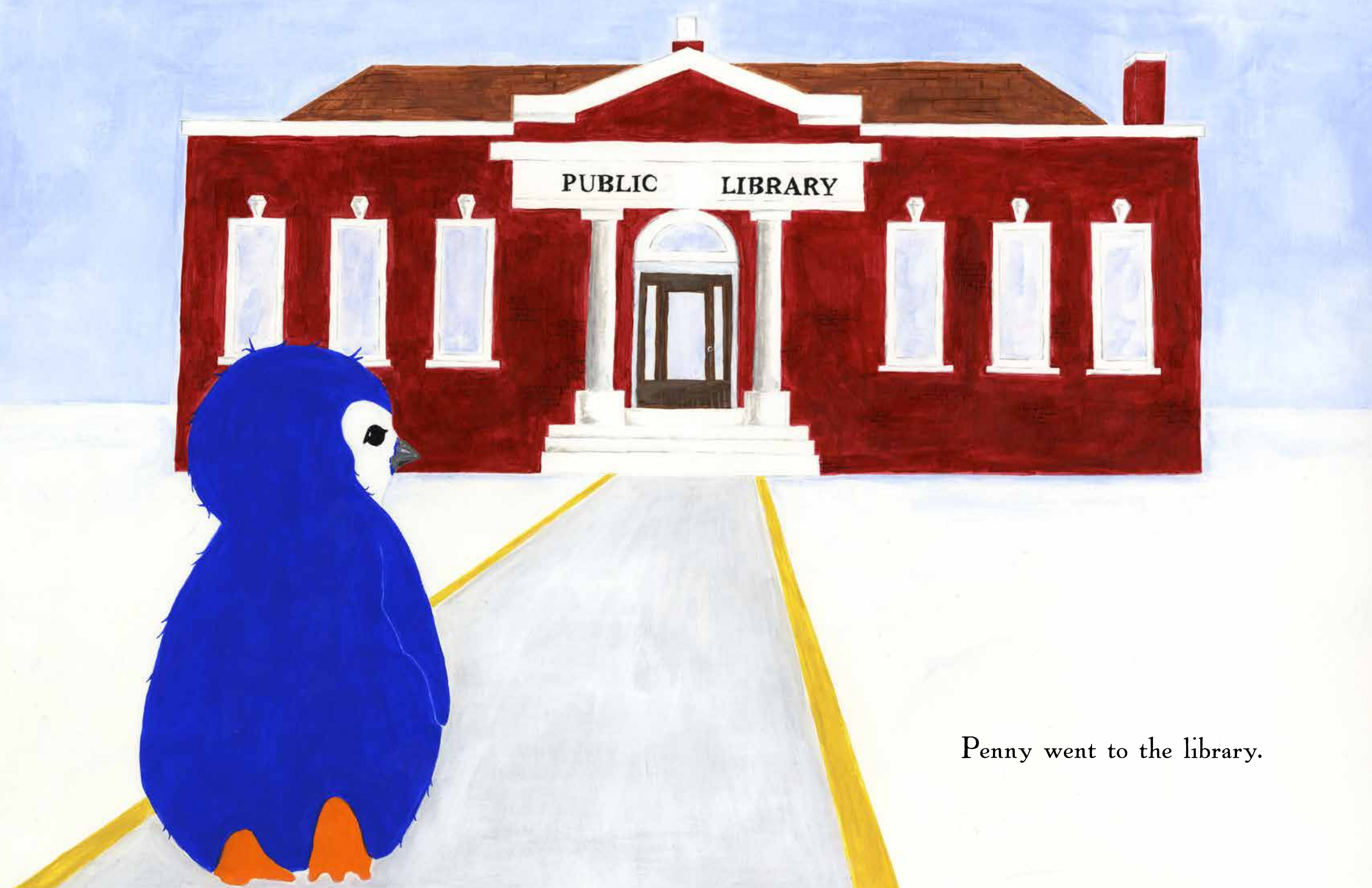


All Penny wanted was to fly.
